Instrumental Music Teacher

Job description	Teaching instrumental music on a sessional basis to students of Mount Evelyn Christian School within the bounds of the 'Instrumental Music Teaching Specialist Service Agreement' and according to a scale of instrumental lesson fees set by the school.
Job requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognised music qualifications or when approved, outstanding demonstrated ability. • Recognised teacher training or significant experience in specialist instrumental music teaching including the ability to teach from primary (with starting age depending on the demands of the instrument) to VCE. • Demonstrated teacher-student and teacher-parent rapport. • An active Christian faith. • ABN (as the school will pass on fees to you as a private business according to the number of lessons taught).
Works with	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will report directly to the Instrumental Coordinator in matters regarding tuition and performance. • You will also at times need to work co-operatively with other Instrumental Teachers and school staff.
Tasks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teaching instrumental music on a weekly sessional basis to students assigned by the Instrumental Tuition Coordinator. • Providing students with a programme of learning tailored to their individual needs and learning styles. • Advising students on the purchase or hire of appropriate materials, such as instruments and music books, with reference to music syllabuses, budget and copyright. • Keeping parents informed of student progress and needs via periodic conversation (preferably in writing) and the writing of reports each semester. • The participation in or direction of instrumental ensembles where required by and in co-operation with the Instrumental Coordinator (in most cases you will be remunerated for these events). • Preparation of students for Instrumental Music Recitals and other performance opportunities within the school as advised by the Instrumental Coordinator. • Attendance at evening Instrumental Music Recitals (in most cases you will be remunerated for these events). • Entering students for external exams, eisteddfods or other performance opportunities where appropriate for the student.
